At this meeting, we:

- Reviewed the draft Evaluation Report of the implementation of the Year One Action Plan and made recommendations to improve implementation of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Plan.
- Confirmed the agenda for the Congress Reunion planned for Saturday, June 4, 2016 in Peace River.

WHAT WE DO

The Archdiocesan Pastoral Council is a consultative body for the benefit of the Archbishop of Grouard-McLennan. It is made up of representatives of the clergy, Religious and laity of the Archdiocese.

Things to share...

- The Faith Rally 2016 will be in Grouard, August 19-21, 2016. Jubilee of Mercy is the theme and Archbishop Pettipas is the keynote speaker. There will be panel discussions, sing-alongs, activities for children, and more!
- Planning for Parish Mission 2017 is well underway. Four priests of the Companions of the Cross will preach in deaneries 2—5, from March 11 – 23, 2017. A Redemptorist priest will preach in deanery 1, in French, March 25—April 5, 2017. Each deanery will host one priest for two one-week missions, in two parishes.
- The Peace River Museum will host the Witness Blanket exhibit, July and August 2016 (see <http://witnessblanket.ca> for more information).
- Encourage deaneries 3, 4, and 5 to consider hosting an appreciative inquiry (Moving Toward Reconciliation) like the one held in Peace River on May 7, 2016.
